Coronavirus Update #7.1

Clarification to statement made in yesterdays update.

In yesterdays coronavirus update it was stated that:

We are currently not prescribing the combination of Azithromycin Z-Pack and Hydroxychloroquine. Several studies are evaluating the safety and efficacy of this treatment and as soon as it has been approved we may reconsider our stance on the treatment.

As of late Sunday night the FDA has approved a EUA (emergency use authorization) to allow this treatment, we were not aware of this Monday morning when the update was released.

The good news is that we do not have anyone that meets the requirements of positive test and symptomatic. Even better news is that when the drug was 1st discussed as a possible treatment weeks ago we aggressively acquired both drugs and currently could potentially treat hundreds of our patients if the need were to arise.

Treatment plans will be on a case by case basis and possibly with the consultation of an Infectious Disease doctor, *in no case will we be prescribing this on a prophylactic basis.*

So while we are prepared in the event this thing turns much worse and we actually have symptomatic confirmed positive patients, we are not there yet, thankfully.
